The Domaine de Belvize is located in the heart of the Minervois region, occupying a vast amphitheater overlooking the Aude valley, between the Montagne Noire and the Canal du Midi.

The vines of Château Belvize are at the heart of a terroir well oriented to benefit from sunshine all day long, and characterized by low rainfall. As a result harvest are naturally small but the grapes have a very good concentration of sugars and aromatics. In 2010, the cultivation system was changed to organic farming, with mechanical weeding, non-chemical fertilizers and phytosanitary treatments with sulfur and very limited doses of copper.

The production wine in the cellar of Château Belvize continues the qualitative process by using only vinification products approved for the organic label, obtained in 2014.








Conceive wine as a tribute. A song. Imagine this landscape as a partition discovered in a museum of ancient music.

Winery overview:



From their first visit in 2004, Claude and Lydia Bourguignon had the intuition that this terroir lends itself particularly well to red wines. According to them, basalt is rich in trace elements which bring passion, and in magnesia, responsible for beautiful bitterness that gives length and nobility to wines.

Over the years, thanks to the work done to restore the life of the soil, these characteristics have become more and more assertive. And the transition to biodynamic cultuvation now allows us to reinforce this evolution







Clos des Nines AOC Languedoc, Languedoc





The estate is named after its three daughters, (nines in the traditional langue d'oc).







Winery overview:

Clos des Nines is a small property of 10 hectares of vines on slopes and olive trees nested in the garrigue between Montpellier and Sète. Isabelle Mangeard started this new adventure in 2003 as a complete change of life style.

The entire estate is located on typical chalky-clay Languedoc soils with fossilised oyster shells.

The vines are on average 30 years old and planted on gentle slopes. The Carignan are over 80 years old.

An organic certification has been signed in august 2013

The harvest exclusively done by hand. Extreme attention is brought to the sanitary aspect and phenolic maturity of the berries. The yields are naturally low at 30-35 hectoliters/hectare

The harvest is destemmed. Each varietal is vinified separately.







Domaine Grand Guilhem Vin de France, Languedoc



The wines of the Grand Guilhem estate: nuggets to discover



Winery overview:

Domaine Grand Guilhem is a 10.4 ha family and artisanal wine estate certified in organic farming since 2004 and producing natural wines (manual harvest, fermentation using natural yeasts, without added sulfites or other input).

It has a structure of accommodation in charming Bed and Breakfast and Gîtes, with a 19th century manor house and outbuildings.

Located overlooking Cascastel, a small wine village of 200 inhabitants in the "Vallée du Paradis", it is ideally located in the heart of the Cathar country and 25 km from the beaches of the Mediterranean.











Domaine Le Nouveau Monde AOC Languedoc, Languedoc







The estate owes its name to the former owner of the place and his friendship with Henri de Montfreid, a French adventurer and writer.



Winery overview:

This vineyard of 20 ha established in south of Béziers, property of the Borras-Gauch family for several generations, is located between sea and pond, on a Villafranchian terrace of rolled pebbles mixed with red clay, and under the influence of Mediterranean. Anne-Laure, oenologist, and Sébastien Borras, restaurateur, took orders in 2003.

The estate owes its name to Henri de Montfreid, a famous French adventurer who returned from South America had found the location so wild and beautiful, that he pushed his friend to call it "the New World".

Domaine La Prade Mari AOC Minervois, Languedoc





Eric Mari is an unclassifiable winemaker. We come to see it from very far away to understand what respect for nature, fauna and flora is. There's no treatment and no cheating



Winery overview:

25 km from Narbonne and 45 km from Carcassonne and Bézier, Domaine La Prade Mari is located in the south of the Hérault department in the Languedoc Roussillon region. Rooted in an atypical Mediterranean terroir, Eric MARI has a variety of indigenous grape varieties whose blending offers powerful wines, combining structure, elegance and harmony.

The natural method of cultivation is the wish of an artisan winegrower who respects his land and his vine.

The Domaine LA PRADE MARI comprises 24 hectares of silty-clay soil planted with Syrah, Carignan, Mourvèdre, Grenache but also Viognier and Roussanne.

The yield per hectare is 20 hl on average depending on the vintage. Total production represents 70,000 bottles per year (70% of which is exported).

Our discoveries 2022:

<u>Domaine PRADELS-QUARTIRONI:</u> AOC Saint Chinian, Languedoc







In 2008, Guilhem and Magali Quartironi took over from their parents Armelle and Roger at the head of this estate created in 1950 by their grandparents and now run organically.

Winery overview:

For 3 generations, the Quartironi family has exercised their profession as winegrowers with passion at the Domaine des Pradels Quartironi. It currently has an area of 14 hectares. Guilhem and Magali Quartironi lead the estate, in Organic Agriculture, in the Saint Chinian appellation.

The terroir of schists benefits from an exceptional situation, which favors the development of subtle aromas and the characteristic freshness of their wines.

The vines are surrounded by woods of holm oaks, arbutus, pines, some chestnut trees, heather, cistus, cades, junipers, thymes, and other aromatic plants, inhabited by many insects and birds, a rich and beautiful biodiversity....

They grow grape varieties: Carignan noir (old vines), Grenache noir, Syrah, Mourvèdre, Cinsault, Grenache blanc, Carignan blanc, Roussanne

Domaine la YOLE:

Domaine La Yole likes to cultivate the vine by raising its wines with ancestral techniques and traditions whose origins date back nearly 2,000 years.

Winery overview:

It was at the beginning of the 17th century, Maître Laguiole Avocat, the new owner of the estate, gave it its name: la YOLE. In 1954, bought the estate of 110 Ha which has since been owned by the same family.

It is Jean Gassier the father who will begin the diversification of our activities by creating a campsite in the early 1970s, then in the early 80s the qualitative conversion of the vineyard.

Today, a horse pension has been created (stable for owners housing 20 animals), and an educational farm, a restaurant and a point of sale of fruit and vegetables produced on the estate have been opened in the summer.

Villa DONDONA:

AOC Languedoc, Languedoc





... a precious terroir forgotten in the garrigue called Dondone

Winery overview:

VILLA DONDONA was created in 1998 on 18 hectares of wild hillside, at 200m altitude, dominating the village of Montpeyroux, Cru du Languedoc.

Meeting of two personalities, a British artist in love with the south and a doctor who has become a winegrower.

The maintenance of the vineyard is organic, with green harvesting and bud pruning.

Inter-row ploughing allows a better ventilation and diminishes the risk of contamination by diseases in creating a more even maturity.

The red grapes that grow at ground level in the heat of the Mediterranean sun give powerful, aromatic wines with character. White grapes are protected by a fresh pergola in the shade to produce pleasant, mineral, fruity wines with a nice acidity. The wine-making and aging cellar amidst the underground vines is a bit inaccessible.
